- 8) **The Gift of TONGUES or LANGUAGES:** The ability to speak a language not previously _____ to the speaker.

- 9) **The Gift of INTERPRETATION:** The ability to interpret and _____ what is said when the gift of tongues/languages is used.

God's People: A Family... Nation... Bride... Flock... and Body

1 Corinthians 12:12 -

1) You have a unified body that is not threatened/hindered but is rather _____ by its diversity.

Matthew 16:18 -

2) Like a physical body, the Body of Christ is not threatened or hindered by its diversity; it thrives, flourishes, and is _____ by each diverse part functioning for the glory of God.

1 Corinthians 12:4-10 -

3) Our shared life in Christ, our shared baptism ("placement") into the Body of Christ, our shared "drinking" (reception or filling) of the Holy Spirit serves as the _____ of our unity and equality!

1 Corinthians 12:13 -

Note: It is Jesus Himself (by virtue of His atoning work) who "baptizes" us (who sends, who fills us) with the Spirit so that we become and are _____ His Body!

Mark 1:7-8; John 1:33-34; John 7:37-39 -

Questions for Further Study, Reflection, and Application...

1. Why is it so important to know and remember that spiritual gifts (manifestations of the Spirit) are given "for the common good" (verse 7)? What will happen if we forget or ignore that principle?
2. Why is discernment, "the ability to distinguish between spirits" (verse 10), so important to the body?
3. What role does humility play in properly thinking about and understanding spiritual gifts?
4. Why is diversity beneficial to both a physical body and to Christ's Body (the Church)?
5. According to verse 13, what is our basis of unity and equality in the Body of Christ?
